



Advisory Group Terms of reference

1. Objective

The Board Advisory Group (BAG) is a non-statutory entity of EMHF – the European Men’s Health Forum. Its main function is to advise the Board and Secretariat on how the aims, objectives and goals of EMHF may be met.

2. Membership

Members are leading edge individuals appointed by the Board. They are recognised for the high level of their expertise and for their personal support for EMHF and its objectives.

Membership will aim to reflect the diversity of expertise and backgrounds relevant to the development of EMHF’s mission.

Membership of the Advisory Board is unpaid. Reasonable expenses can however be reimbursed in accordance with EMHF finance policy and upon prior agreement of the secretariat.

Individuals may step down at any time by giving written notice to the President of EMHF. Their role may also be terminated at any time by decision of the Board.

3. Organisation

Expertise from Advisory Group members may be called upon as and when required by EMHF initiative planning. Individuals are not required to interface regularly with any part of EMHF. They are kept regularly informed of EMHF’s developments and may be invited to EMHF-organised meetings and other relevant external events.

Members of the group may seek administrative support from the Secretariat of EMHF for the undertaking of their mission. EMHF cannot be held responsible for the cost of external services contracted by a member of the advisory group without prior approval of the secretariat.
